Colloquium Programme

The colloquium will commence each day at 9.00am for 9.30am opening sessions.

Friday concludes at 6.00pm with 6.30pm drinks followed by dinner at the Seminary of the Good Shepherd.

Saturday concludes at 5.00pm.

Key addresses will be:

- The patristic tradition of preaching,
- The Word of God as vital source for preaching,
- A radical call to conversion,
- The tradition of lay preaching in the church,
- Fostering lay preaching in ecclesial movements,
- Key elements in evangelical preaching
- Preaching to men,
- The proclamation to youth.

This two day colloquium will consist of talks, workshops, open forums, testimonies and a concluding Plenary Session.

About CREDO

The Archbishop of Sydney, George Cardinal Pell, has a clear goal for the revitalisation of parish life and the active promotion of the Catholic faith within the Archdiocese. CREDO embraces this mandate and has as its purpose to put the whole of the Archdiocese on a missionary footing.

On 3 October 2003, Cardinal Pell appointed Auxiliary Bishop Julian Porteous as Episcopal Vicar for Renewal and Evangelisation. The role was to be one of promotion of the New Evangelisation as encouraged by Pope John Paul II and to foster authentic church renewal within the Archdiocese.

In particular, CREDO has as its goal the engagement of the entire resources of the Archdiocese in a clear focus on evangelisation, taking up the challenge of Pope Paul VI's statement in *Evangelii Nuntiandi* (n 14), "The Church exists in order to evangelise".

We encourage every work of the Archdiocese and beyond, to develop a self-understanding whereby it sees its place in proclaiming Christ and authentic Catholic teaching.

CREDO aims to:

- create opportunities for existing groups and movements involved in evangelisation to work together in engaging more closely with this overall mission of proclaiming Jesus Christ and encouraging greater co-operation with each other.
- promote the notion of evangelisation, especially the "New Evangelisation" espoused by Pope John Paul II, and to develop a collection of resources for evangelisation to assist parishes and to offer training programmes in evangelisation.
- initiate movements in the Archdiocese which focus on groups or individuals within the Church becoming actively engaged for the first time in this mission of evangelisation.
