CZESTOCHOWA RETREAT

Czestochowa is home to the cherished miraculous icon of **Our Lady with the Child Jesus**, an object of veneration for centuries. Jasna Gora is also known as the Black Madonna and is one of the most famous Marian shrines in Europe. While on retreat we will reflect on Pope John Paul II's call for the New Evangelisation

DAY 5

SATURDAY 15TH SEPTEMBER
WODOWICE

Departing Czestochowa this morning we travel to **Wodowice**, the birthplace of Karol Wojtyla where we see his family house and the ground where he used to play Football! The central point of the town is the market square with its Basilica (**Parish Church**), with the famous Baptismal basin where Karol was baptized. Next to the church we find the Pope's birthplace and the nearby Museum encompassing the former home of the Wojtyla family. On route to Krakow we visit the celebrated Marian site of **Kalwaria Zebrzydowska**, which remains the favourite boyhood shrine of Pope John Paul II.

This afternoon we come to Krakow and to the inspired **Shrine of Divine Mercy** where, between 1931 – 1938 Our Lord appeared to **Saint Faustina**, a Sister of Mercy in Poland, entrusting with her the mission of spreading devotion to the Divine Mercy. During our visit we will celebrate Mass at the shrine, witnessing the **miraculous image of the Merciful Jesus** and venerating the tomb of Saint Faustina (special prayers at 3.00 pm, the Hour of Mercy).

The Congress is for normal baptised people to be really encouraged to go on mission, and learn about the exciting developments of the NEW EVANGELISATION taking place in Europe.

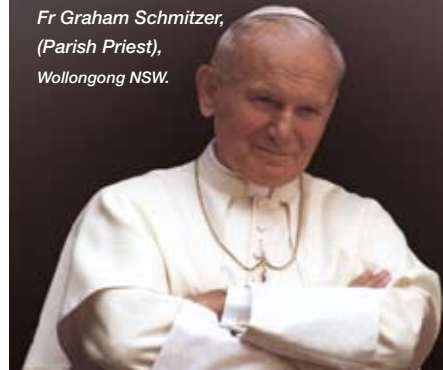
This is the last of 5 annual city-wide missions (ICNE's) which have taken place in Vienna, Paris, Lisbon, Brussels and Budapest.

Simple Booking procedures

- Phone Harvest Australia and place your reservation, and if known, any other extension plans
- Send a \$300 deposit per person, plus insurance payment with completed pilgrim's booking form
- Await letter of confirmation containing receipt and further details, including any visa forms etc. (follow Harvest instructions)
- Make balance of payment 7 weeks prior to departure date
- Await receipt of all tour documents, wallet, cabin bag and Pilgrim's Journal 2 weeks prior to departure
- Tour costs are subject to achieving a minimum group size.
